RULES FOR THE ROTARY CLUB OF WESSEX MEAD YOUNG PHOTOGRAPHER COMPETITION



1. Objectives

This competition is to encourage young people to:

- Experiment with photography
- Use either digital or traditional methods of photography
- Show interpretation of a given topic
- Express their ideas through the medium of photography

2. Entrants

There are three age categories, with ages taken on 31st August 2009:

JUNIOR: Aged 7 – 10 years

INTERMEDIATE: Aged 11 – 13 years

SENIOR: Aged 14 – 17 years.

3. Competition

The theme for all the age categories will be: **“THE ENVIRONMENT”**

Entrants will be asked to submit a single print, either colour or black and white, no larger than A4 size. In addition each entrant will be asked to explain in no more than 50 words, what inspired them to take the photograph. All entries must be accompanied by an official entry form attached.

4. Format

The judge will be Ron Pybus, Master Photographer of Pybus Studios. He will view the entries in each age category and consider:

- the Technical Merit
- Content and Composition
- Imagination & Style

The judge will award a prize to the “best photograph” in each age category. At the judges discretion, Highly Commended may be awarded. The prizes have kindly been donated by Clives Cameras, Trowbridge.

5. Closing date

All entries MUST be received by 18th September 2009
